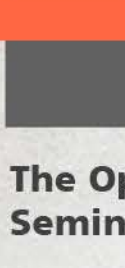
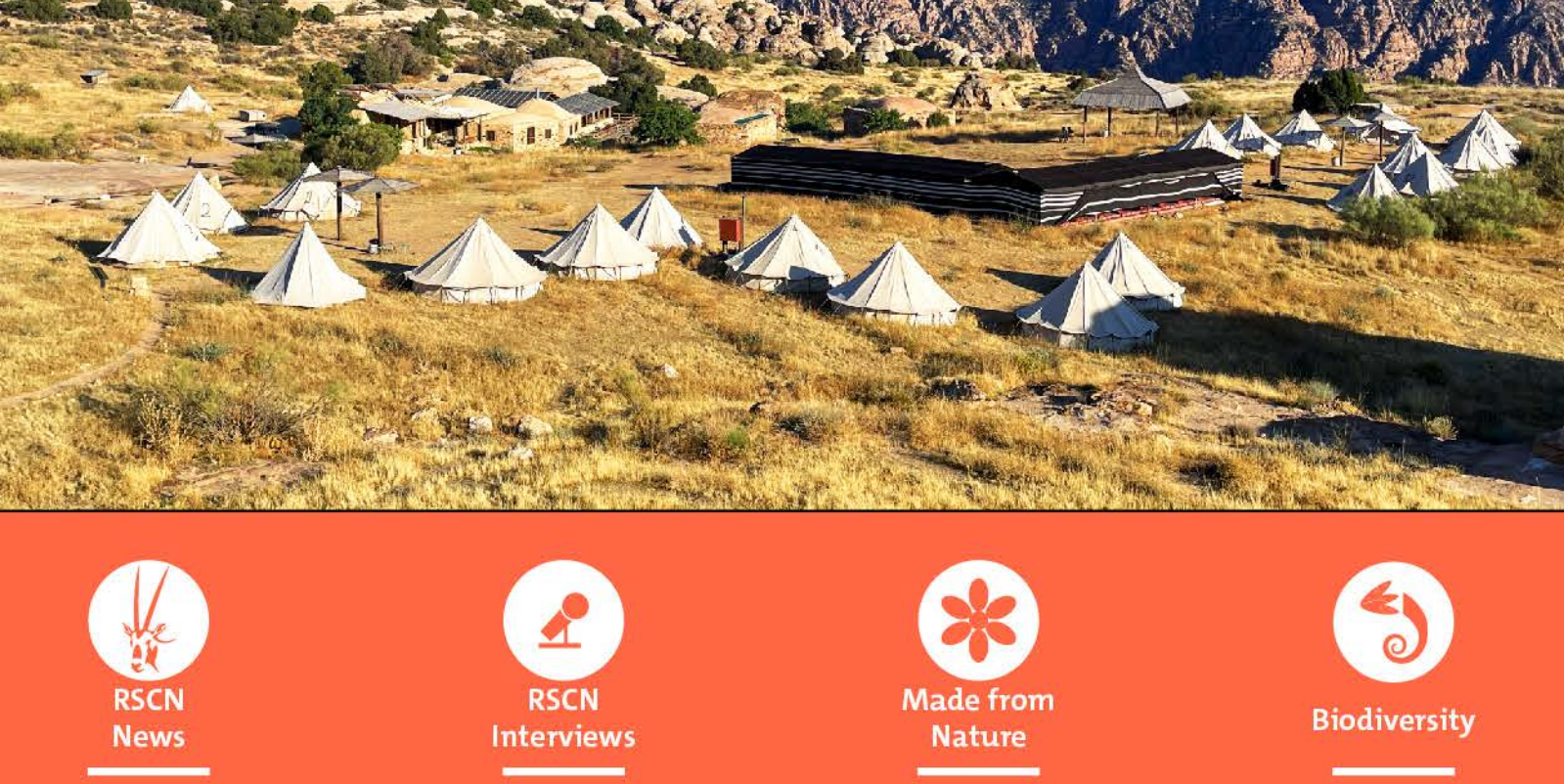

1 The Opening of The Regional Leadership Seminar on Protected Areas Management

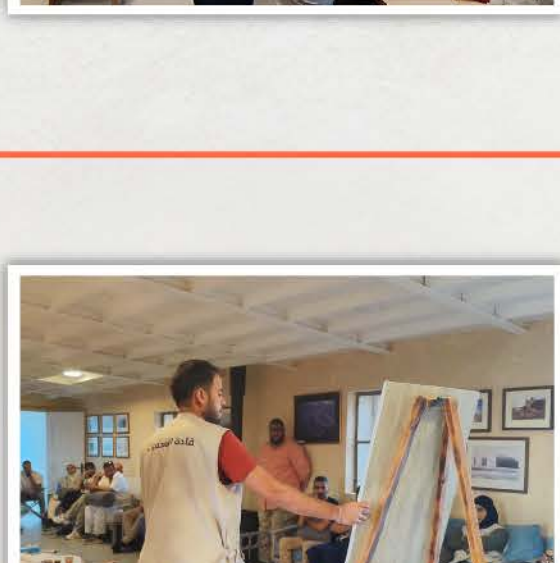

9 The Royal Society for the Conservation of Nature participated in the Rotary Conference, themed "Thinking Green... Living Green"

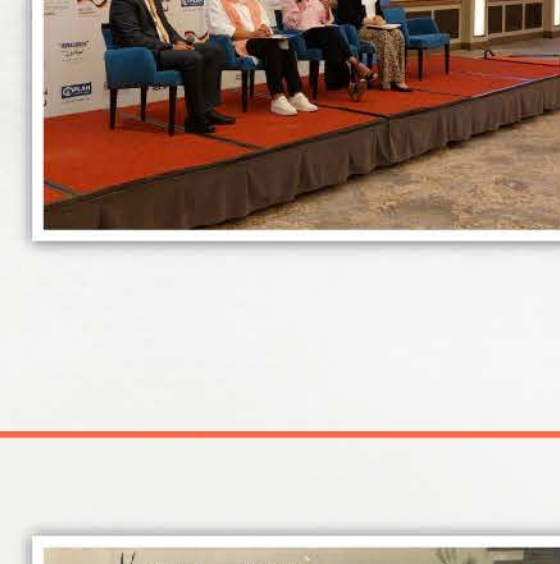

12 World Environment Day Activity

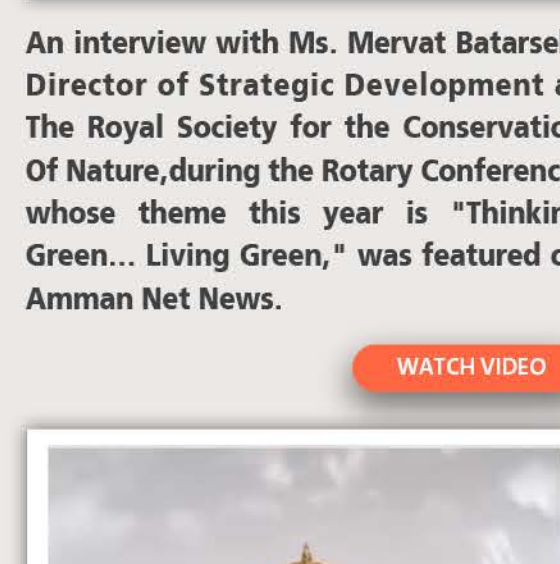

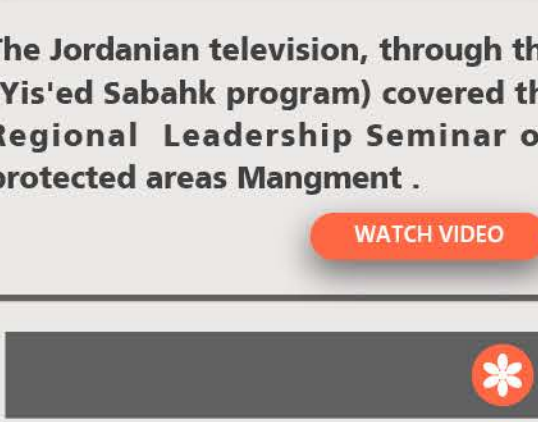
13 Releasing of the first issue of the eleventh volume of the Jordanian Journal of Natural History

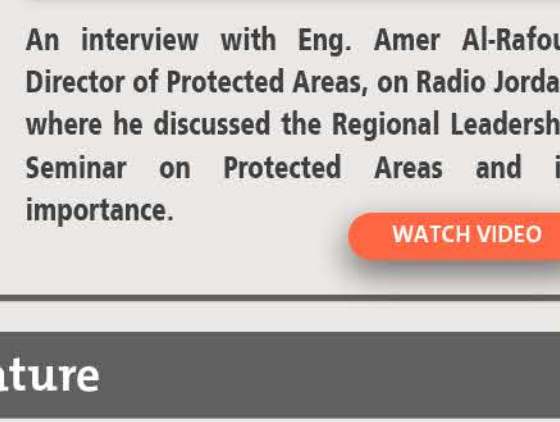
